#### Main evolution from 2014

- Among the European partners
  - Agrinatura (CIRAD and NRI only)
  - KM&Com officer
  - Deputy manager (Agrinatura)
- In the brokerage mechanism
  - Communication and advocacy strategy
  - Management of partnerships (consortia and ULPs)
  - Selected projects through CRF
  - Need analysis in capacity for generating ARD funds

### Main bottlenecks identified so far

- Lack of ownership by the partners
  - African partners (francophone in particular)
  - European research partners
- Poor consideration of research by FO
  - ULPs have not identified real research topics
  - Not reactive enough to adapt to each call
- Funding opportunities not appealing to European actors

## Achievements and progress so far

- Four running funded projects (CRF)
- > Four Regional brokerage workshops
- > Four writeshops dedicated to specific calls
- ➤ Information sharing to a larger range of funding opportunities
- ➤ Monitoring and communication tool in place (intranet and internet sites)
