Agrinatura, the European Alliance on Agricultural Knowledge for Development, is an Association of 34 European Universities and Research centres supporting agricultural research and development (ARD) by establishing research project consortia, leading science policy dialogue, and providing an evidence based knowledge platform or capacity building to improve the livelihoods of farmers and their communities.





Agrinatura and its members have common interests in supporting sustainable agricultural development to improve people's lives and to contribute to achieving the goals of the United Nations Agenda 2030 and The European Green Deal by:

- playing a pro-active policy advocacy role for agricultural research and education for development in Europe and worldwide:
- working with a network of partner organisations across the world that share our vision;
- developing, strengthening, and encouraging strategic alliances, partnerships, and networks with and between the different stakeholders (institutions, organisations, and individuals) worldwide;
- organising, facilitating and implementing joint participation in European and international research programmes and projects
- providing support and advice for evidence-based policy making, in particular at the European level;
- → offering a platform for exchange and dissemination.

AGRINATURA ACTIVITIES

Agrinatura achieves its goals by various activities such as:

1. Leading the science-policy dialogue

- Agrinatura participates in High Level Policy Dialogues with the European Commission (EC), United Nations (UN) and the Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO).
- Agrinatura is invited as the major institutional voice to provide valuable expertise on current topics (EU Green Deal, Farm to Fork strategy).
- Creating and publishing policy briefs and position papers (QR codes to the papers).





2. Connecting with other organisations to further develop global partnerships

- Close collaboration with the Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM).
- Agrinatura is a standing committee in the Association for European Life Science Universities (ICA).
- Supporting youth inclusiveness by cooperating with Youth Professionals for Agriculture and Research Development (YPARD) and International Association of Students in Agricultural and Related Sciences (IAAS).
- Working in synergy with Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) and Tropical Agriculture Platform (FAO TAP).
- Aligning efforts with the Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture (SEARCA).

- 5. Transforming interdisciplinary research expertise and experience into action
- → Agrinatura collaborates in numerous capacity building ERASMUS+ projects, including:
- The PISAI project focused on capacity building in agriculture and natural resources management, implemented in Asian countries.
- The Master of Science in Food Security and Climate Change (MS FSCC) project creating a joint degree offered by members of Southeast Asian Universities.
- Support of International Platform Merging Labour and Education (SIMPLE), encouraging cooperation between academic sector HEIs and the professional sector in the areas of agriculture and life sciences in selected Asian countries.

- → Development and implementation of integrated study programmes:
- Master ACT an integrated joint degree European Master of Sciences Agriculture, Climate, Transition.
- Agris Mundus two-year training master programme in agricultural development and management of natural resources.
- → Collaboration with global partners:
- In partnership with the European Commission Agrinatura delivers the Value Chain Analysis for Development (VCA4D) component of the EC's Inclusive and Sustainable Value Chains and Food Fortification Programme by developing and applying an integrated toolkit to undertake systematic analyses of the value chains.
- Leveraging the DeSIRA initiative for agri-food systems transformation.

 DeSIRA-LIFT supports DeSIRA's current and future activities in order to enhance its impacts.

- Nutrition Research Facility (NRF) is implemented by Agrinatura to provide knowledge and evidence for policy and programme design, management, monitoring and evaluation in order to reach better nutrition outcomes. It provides expert advice to the EC and to the EU.

- Workshops, Discussions and **Events** organised (UNFSS Side Event, InfoPoint's Event, General Assembly Workshops).




AGRINATURA STRUCTURE AND WORKING GROUPS

Agrinatura (1) the Agrinatura Association a non-profit organisation and (2) Agrinatura EEIG the Economic **Interest Grouping.** The highest body of Agrinatura is the General Assembly, including all members, and meets annually, chaired by the President. The management lays in the hands of the Board of Directors for the Association and Advisory Board for the EEIG. The president is seconded by two Vice-presidents representing Agrinatura Association and Agrinatura EEIG. The Agrinatura Association is seated in Belgium with the office in the Czech Republic, staffed with a General Secretary. The Agrinatura EEIG is seated in France with office in UK. Other than the decision-making body. Agrinatura has four Working Groups dealing with specific objectives.
