

Ioannis Dimitriou is an Associate Professor at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU), and Senior Research Advisor at SLU's Vice-Chancellor's office, responsible for international partnerships with low and middle-income countries.

He has been involved in several EU and nationally-funded agriculture for development projects, with most recent examples being LEAP4FNSSA, CEA-FIRST and DeSIRA-LIFT. He is currently serving as Vice-President of Agrinatura (the European Alliance on Agricultural Knowledge for Development).

His research focuses on designing productive systems with food and biomass crops while achieving minimal environmental impact, including recycling different nutrient-rich wastes. In his research and expert role, he has been working in science-policy interfaces to support the implementation of smart innovation in agriculture contributing to the sustainable transformation of food systems.

Dimitriou is the author of more than 100 peer-reviewed articles, a member of several PhD examination committees, and an organiser of PhD courses at SLU and partner universities.
